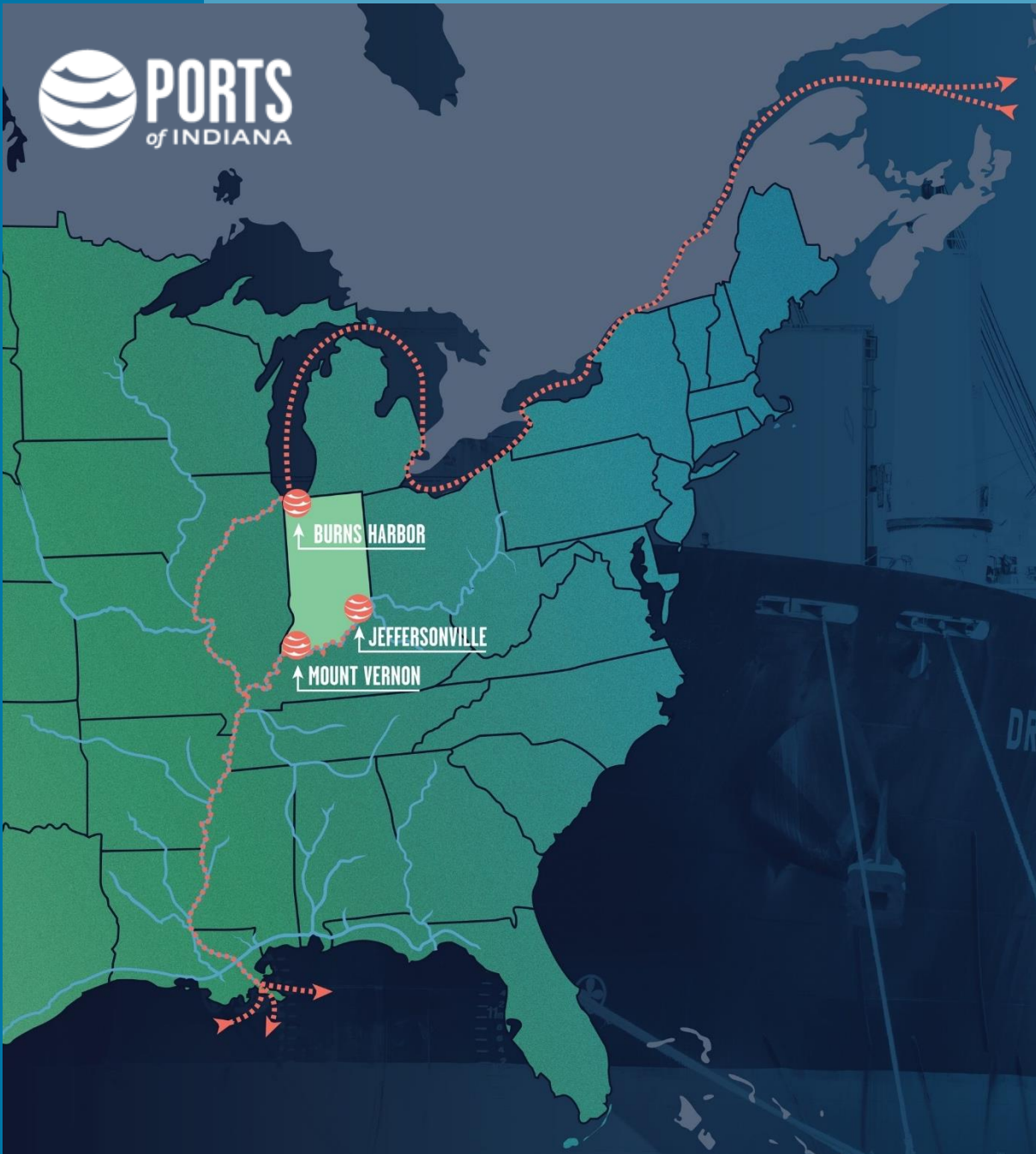

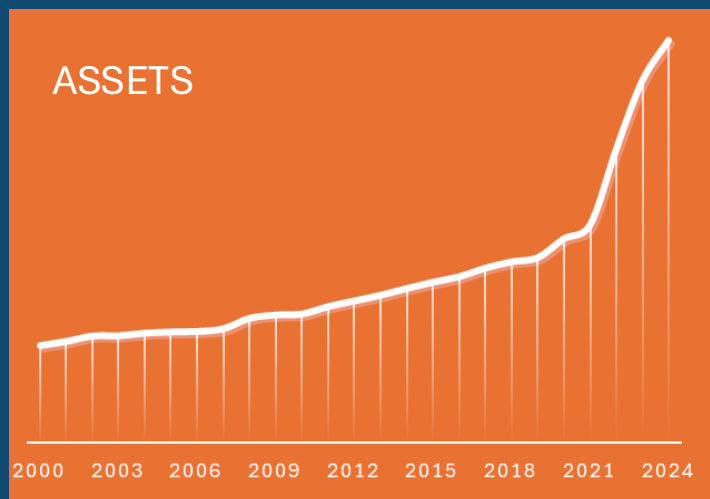

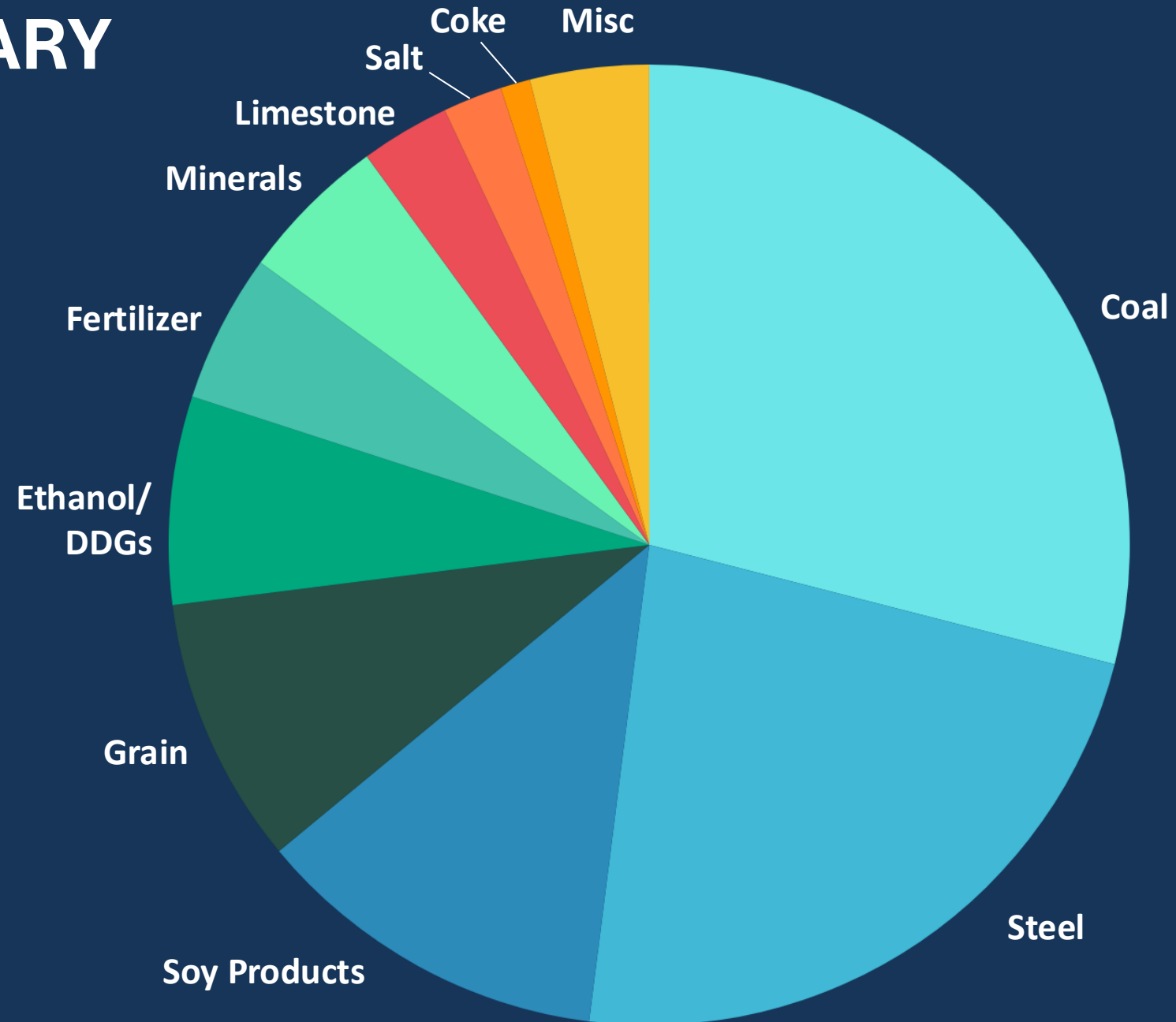


SHIPPING SUMMARY

LOUIS DREYFUS – BURNS HARBOR



- Global powerhouse reopens one of Great Lakes largest export terminals
- “Big Four” ag company - \$50 billion in sales, 100 million tons annually

Ag Export Terminal:

- \$18M in facility upgrades
- 7.2M bushels of storage
- Access to 16 railroads
- Loads 90K bushels per hour
- Simultaneously transload for ocean vessel, unit train, truck
